The FBLA-Middle Level Merit Award is a membership engagement-focused challenge that chapters may complete for national recognition. By completing activities, chapters work toward filling out the MERIT “BINGO” card. In addition, FBLA-ML chapters may explore a monthly choice board created to offer additional ideas for activities. Advisers will find these boards in the Leadership Community. Added incentives such as ribbons at conferences, national recognition in publications, and plaques will be awarded.

**HOW TO PARTICIPATE:** Choose to fill the card “BINGO” style by selecting five tasks horizontal, vertical, or diagonal. Keep track of your chapter’s accomplishments by marking them off.
